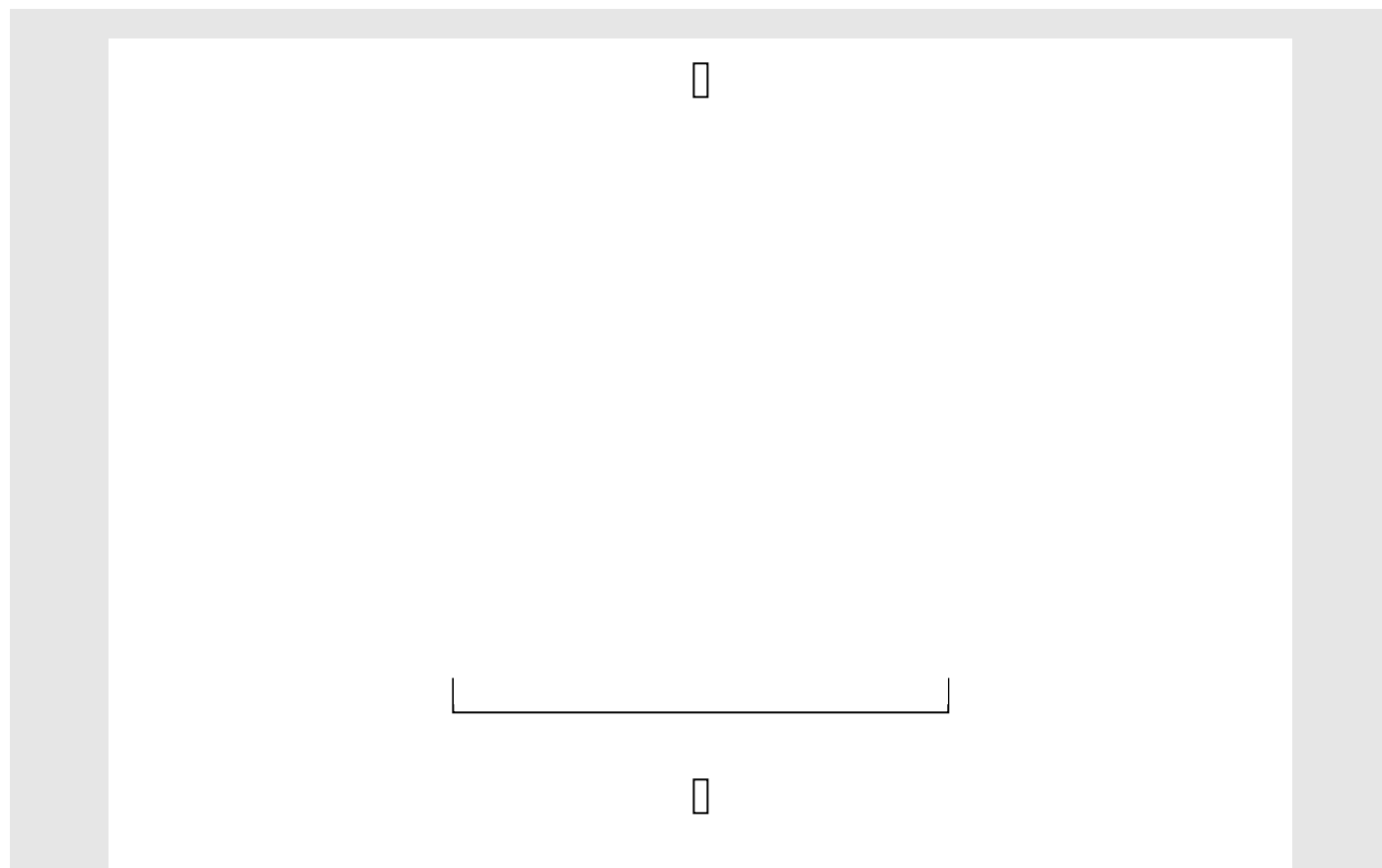

### Emergency Small Business & Microenterprise Assistance Grant Program

**Coos Bay, Oregon** – In response to the economic impact of the COVID-19 pandemic, the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program has been highlighted as a vehicle for providing financial relief to states, communities, and small businesses.

Together, Coos County and Curry County applied and received a \$150,000 CDBG. The awarded CDBG is being used to create the Emergency Small Business and Microenterprise Grant Assistance Program. The new program is intended to help businesses remain solvent through the crisis and be ready and able to rebuild and/or reopen.

#### **Eligible Businesses:**

- Businesses located in Coos County and Curry County.
- Those immediately impacted by the public health restrictions.
- Were generally stable/strong prior to the crisis.
- Employ low to moderate income individuals, or microenterprise business (five or fewer employees, owner is low to moderate income).
- Must have been in business for a minimum of one year.

**Eligible Grant Amount:** \$2,500 - \$10,000

Coos and Curry Counties have partnered with CCD Business Development Corporation (CCD), the regional Economic Development District organization, to administer this grant program. The application will be available at 12:00 pm (noon) on Friday, January 22 at [www.ccdbusiness.org](http://www.ccdbusiness.org) and will close at 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, January 27.

*Funds are limited. Actual grant amount will be determined by an application review process. These funds are intended to be equally accessible to all businesses including the historically disadvantaged population groups (Asian, Black, Hispanic, Native American, and Women Owned Businesses).*

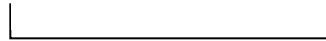
