OVERVIEW

- Resolution No. 395 in 2008, established gear storage rate at \$0.60 per square foot per annum or \$0.05 per square foot per month. Waterfront property was valued at \$18.36 per square foot.
- Resolution No. 438 in 2013, raised all gear storage rates by 5%. 5% increase should have raised the amount to \$0.0525 per square foot per month.
- Resolution No. 468 in Feb. 2017, raised the gear storage rate to \$0.09 per square foot per month.
- Resolution No. 472 in May 2017, ratified all port rates into one document with gear storage rate remaining at \$0.09 per square foot per month.
- June 29, 2017 Special Commissioner Meeting was held and during the meeting commissioners approved suspension of gear storage rate increase until further review.
- If the Port used the latest appraised land values (not waterfront), the rate would approximately be \$0.067 per square foot per month using the same method in 2008.

RESOLUTION NO. 395

A RESOLUTION OF THE PORT OF BROOKINGS HARBOR DEVELOPED AND UNDEVELOPED LAND USE PRICES

WHEREAS, the Port of Brookings Harbor finds it necessary to receive a fair market value based rental return for its developed and undeveloped property; and

WHEREAS, the Port of Newport charges \$0.17 per square foot per month and all crab traps must be moved only by port personnel at lessees expense and the Port of Coos Bay charges \$0.10 per square foot per month for gear storage, but disallows crab trap storage. Both try to receive a 10% return on all properties whether gear storage or building sites; and

WHEREAS, unimproved waterfront property is valued at \$800,000.00 per acre and a 10% return equals \$0.15 per square foot per month; and

WHEREAS, current market condition will not support \$0.15 square feet per month; and

WHEREAS, economic conditions warrants lesser rate at this time:

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the following rental rates be set for developed and undeveloped property;

1. \$0.60 per square foot per annum.

Moorages- 5% Increase rounded to nearest \$5.00

Cold Storage - 5% on all fees

RV Park – 5% on all spaces

Repair Yard Activities - 5% equipment rental & haul outs

Gear & Boat Storage – 5% on all spaces

Ice house - \$65,00 per ton

Section 2. Boat Yard

A routine maintenance haul-out or launch is not an emergency. An emergency situation exists only when a vessel is distressed to the degree that it is taking on water at a rate that will cause damage that can be prevented by removing the vessel from the water.

Haul-out and repair yard charges must be paid in full prior to launch or at the end of each 30 days the vessel remains in the repair yard. Haul-out includes one hour of in strap for boat wash. 1-hour minimum on hourly rates.

Yard days may be reduced due to inclement weather by port manager approval. No long term storage rates for boats in the boat yard. All boats in storage yard charged as stated below.

- Resolution No. 403 in Nov 2008, approved \$0.025 per gallon fee for any fueling over the docks.
- Fueling over the dock fee was raised in early 2015. Invoices from March 2015 to June 2017 had \$0.06 per gallon fee.
- Resolution No. 472 in May 2017, ratified all port rates into one document, with a new rate for Fuel-Over-Dock at \$0.08 per gallon.

RESOLUTION NO. 403 A RESOLUTION OF THE PORT OF BROOKINGS HARBOR OVER-THE-DOCK FUELING FEE

WHEREAS, all independent fuel distributors utilize the Port's docks for the transfer of fuel to vessels at the Port Of Brookings Harbor.

WHEREAS, federal regulations require a spill containment plan from the independent fuel distributor, for any boat with a capacity of 10,500 gallons or more.

WHEREAS, there are no legal requirements for a spill containment plan for boats with a capacity of less than 10,500 gallons.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Port of Brookings Harbor will charge a fee of \$.025 per gallon for the fuel transferred from an independent fuel distributor to any boat fueled from the docks of the Port of Brookings Harbor. The Port reserves the right to separately negotiate fees, in particular circumstances, at the discretion of the Port manager. The fees cover the Ports administrative cost for managing the Over-the-Dock fueling program, plus the use of the dock. The Port provides the work boat and fuel containment booms of sufficient size to contain fuel spills to the commercial basin.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Port of Brookings Harbor will require insurance from the independent fuel distributor. Boat owners are liable for all costs associated with the clean-up from any spill resulting from the transfer of fuel to their vessel.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Commissioners of the Port of Brookings Harbor:
