RESOLUTION NO. 2026-04**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE PORT OF BROOKINGS HARBOR
ADOPTING STANDARDS FOR GRANTING OF PERMIT FOR SALES OF FISH
PRODUCT OFF BOAT**

WHEREAS, the Port of Brookings Harbor is a port district, organized and operated under the provisions of ORS Chapter 777, and has the authority to adopt resolutions; and

WHEREAS, the Port finds it necessary and desirable to encourage the productivity and economic welfare of the commercial fishing industry based out of the Port of Brookings Harbor, and

WHEREAS, members of the commercial fishing community have requested permission to sell products directly off their boats,


NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of Commissioners of the Port of Brookings Harbor, Curry County, Oregon as follows:

1. The attached document "Permit for Sales of Fish Product (Off Boat)" is incorporated herein by reference as Exhibit A.
2. All previous resolutions are hereby repealed.
3. The following procedures shall be complied with in the issuance of permits to sell products off of a fishing vessel moored in the Port of Brookings Harbor:
 - a) All vessels off of which fish product is to be sold shall have a properly executed standard moorage agreement with the Port of Brookings Harbor.
 - b) All permits for sale of fish product off a vessel are personal to the permit holder and are not assignable or transferable in any form or fashion. Permits shall not be transferred by virtue of transfer of ownership of a vessel. Any attempt, in any fashion, to transfer, sell, or assign a permit shall be absolutely void.
 - c) As a pre-condition for the issuance of each permit, each permit applicant shall sign a document which shall obligate the signer to save, defend, and hold harmless the Port of Brookings Harbor for any liability or injuries in connection with the activities of the permit holder.
 - d) A permit holder shall always comply with all government regulations in any fashion connected to or related to all activities of the permit holder conducted under the auspices of the permit.
 - e) The cost of a permit under this Resolution shall be set by the Standard Port Rates and may be revised from time to time at the discretion of the Board of Commissioners, and permits shall be valid for a term up to one year.
 - f) Revocation of Permits. At any time upon default of any condition or requirement set forth in this Resolution or in event of non-payment in advance of the required fee, the Port Manager or his Designee may revoke without advance notice the permit of any holder to

conduct any activity hereunder. To enforce revocation of the permit, the Port Manager or his Designee may revoke the moorage agreement of the permit holder, may seek injunctive relief in court, or may take any other action as permitted by law.

4. All permits issued to any permit holder shall be signed by the Port Manager or his Designee of the Port or his designee, and the permit holder. Above the signature of the permit holder shall be a clause or term whereby the permit holder agrees to abide by all the terms and conditions under this Resolution.

This document constitutes a permit for the sales of raw fish or fish product off the Vessel _____ and is issued to the signatory below. This permit is personal to the signatory below and may not be assigned or transferred. The permittee hereunder hereby agrees to save, defend and hold harmless Port of Brookings Harbor for any liability or injuries in connection with the activities of the permit holder. The permit holder agrees that he or she shall comply with all the standards for granting of a permit for sales of fish product as set forth in Resolution No. 2026-04 of the Port of Brookings Harbor, the terms of which are incorporated by reference herein, and acknowledges that he or she has received a copy of the same.

In the event of dispute concerning this permit, or for collection of fees, then and in that event the Port of Brookings Harbor shall be entitled to all their reasonable costs and attorney fees, both in connection with the dispute or collection and at trial or appeal there from, if any. The permit holder by his or her signature below agrees to abide by all the terms and conditions of Port of Brookings Harbor Resolution No. 2026-04.
